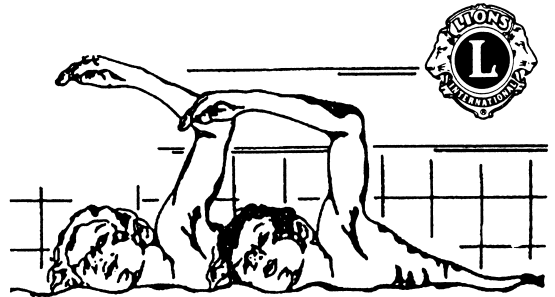

SWIMARATHON 2010

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR THE SPONSORED SWIM

1. The swim will take place at the Clayesmore School Sports Centre, Iwerne Minister, Dorset between 9.00 am and 4.00 pm on both Saturday 27th and Sunday 28th March 2010.
2. The swim is open to all clubs, businesses, schools, associations, youth organisations, family groups, etc.
3. This is a team event for groups of 6 swimmers, one of whom shall be Captain except that in the case of youth teams the Captain must be a non-swimming adult.
4. Entries can be requested by phone, mail or e-mail but must be confirmed by submission of details on the official entry form. There is no entry fee. Entries will be limited to 56 teams and entries could close before 24th March if the maximum has been reached.
5. The pool will be divided into 4 lanes and teams will be allocated a lane when registering. Each swimmer will swim 1 or 2 lengths of the pool before handing over to the next member of the team, and then as in a relay for a total time of 55 minutes. Hence **all** swimmers **must** be capable of swimming 25 metres unaided.
6. All team members should seek sponsorship and the sponsorship forms **must be handed in** at the time of registration. Certified forms will be returned following the swim for collection of outstanding monies.
7. Teams must arrive for registration at least 30 minutes before the nominated swim time. Lane numbers will be allocated then, unless specific lanes have been agreed in advance.
8. All children under the age of 14 must have a parental consent form properly completed on their behalf, and the form must be handed over by their adult organiser to a steward on arrival at the Sports Centre.
9. 2 lengths of the pool equal one lap for scoring purposes. Pool length is 25 metres.
10. It is the team captain's responsibility for ensuring that **all sponsorship monies and forms** are collected and paid/handed to the Lions Club on the day of the swim or as soon as possible afterwards (but no later than 4th June 2010) to the contact below*. Any cheques should be made payable to 'Blackmore Vale Lions Club'.
11. Trophies will be awarded on a points basis in the following categories:-
 - a. Best individual team.
 - b. Runners-up.
 - c. Best junior team (all swimmers under 14 years of age).
 - d. Best aggregate of all teams from one organisation.

In addition the President's shield will be awarded for noteworthy achievement / effort.

Any Junior swimmers in the above winning categories will also be awarded individual medals whilst **all** Junior swimmers will be awarded participation certificates.

12. Swimming aids may be permitted – check with a poolside attendant. Their use, however, could stop the team being considered for awards of trophies and/or medals.
13. The Blackmore Vale Lions Club reserves the right to make such alterations to the above as may be considered necessary for the efficient and safe organisation of the event.

Don't forget to bring your swimming trunks / costume, tracksuit or warm clothing, towel and your sponsorship forms.

Remember – your full support means another successful Swimarathon!
